Welcome

We welcome you as a member and we would like to bring to your attention the following:
This is a Family Club where we encourage a friendly and happy atmosphere.
We wish to advise you of our policies, expectations our values and principles.

Visitors / Guests of club members May only be signed in for up to three visits after that it is required that the guest or visitor joins our club.

Courtesy Van. The RSA promotes a **No Drink Drive policy** and as such encourages members to utilize our Courtesy Van that currently operates Monday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights from 5.00pm till closing and every second Tuesday. Call 401-2368 for a van to pick you up.

Behaviour. We are a Club. All rules will be abided by or you may be asked to leave the club premise. Any fighting, arguing, theft of RSA, visitor's or member's property, or behaviour that could bring the club into disrepute will **NOT** be tolerated. Smoking is NOT allowed in our premises at any time. We have a garden bar outside for smokers.

Foul Language. This will NOT be tolerated. You will be asked for a donation to our swear jar should you lapse. In more serious cases you may be asked to leave the club. The Executive Committee & Bar Staff have the right to police this.

Dress code. Members and all visitors are expected to maintain a neat and tidy standard of dress. Women are to have their shoulders covered and men to have a tidy t-shirt/ shirt. Footwear must be worn on Club premise at all times, jandals or sandals are acceptable, NO GUMBOOTS OR SOCKS are permitted. The Executive Committee & Bar Staff have the right to police this.

Visitors. We encourage you to introduce new members and visitors, however, there is a three month stand down where you are unable to propose or second new membership applications.

Sections. There are adjuncts that operate within the clubs sanction, should you wish to join in any of them, please speak with the Bar Staff and they will help you. These are as follows: -
Fishing Club, Golf Club, Pool Club and the Women's Section

Children. Children must be off the club premise before 7.30pm

Sale of Alcohol. The Bar Staff have the right to refuse any person service over the bar. The Bar staff have No obligation to serve: A licence does not oblige its holder: (a) to deliver, sell, or supply alcohol at any time or to any person; or (b) to let any person, consume alcohol at any time on the premises the licence is issued for.

Personal Hygiene. A high standard of personal hygiene is required in all aspects of this Club. If requested you may be required to leave the premise and return when remedied.

Executive Committee

- The Executive Committee of the Kaikohe & District Memorial RSA (Inc) has the right to Accept or Decline any new Membership's.
